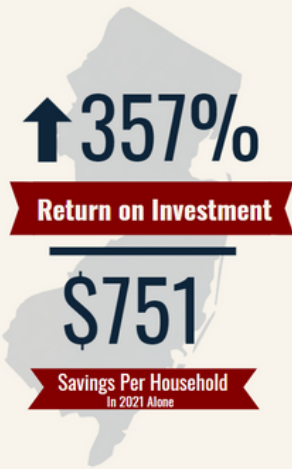
Federal Tax \$ Clawed Back to the Fifth District Since 2016 to Help Cut Taxes

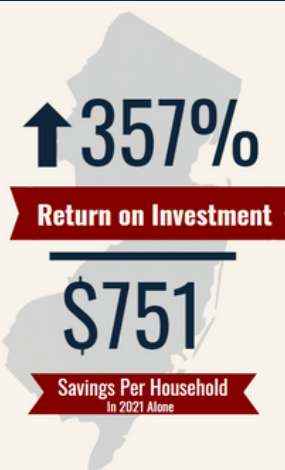

LESO+GSA PROGRAM



Helping our law enforcement agencies get the necessary equipment they need to keep our communities safe

Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) and GSA programs: LESO facilitates the transfer of excess property that might otherwise be destroyed to law enforcement agencies across the United States and its territories. The GSA has a similar program that allows municipalities to obtain items such as: generators, outdoor lights, trucks, furniture, office machines and supplies, and much more at only the cost of shipping.



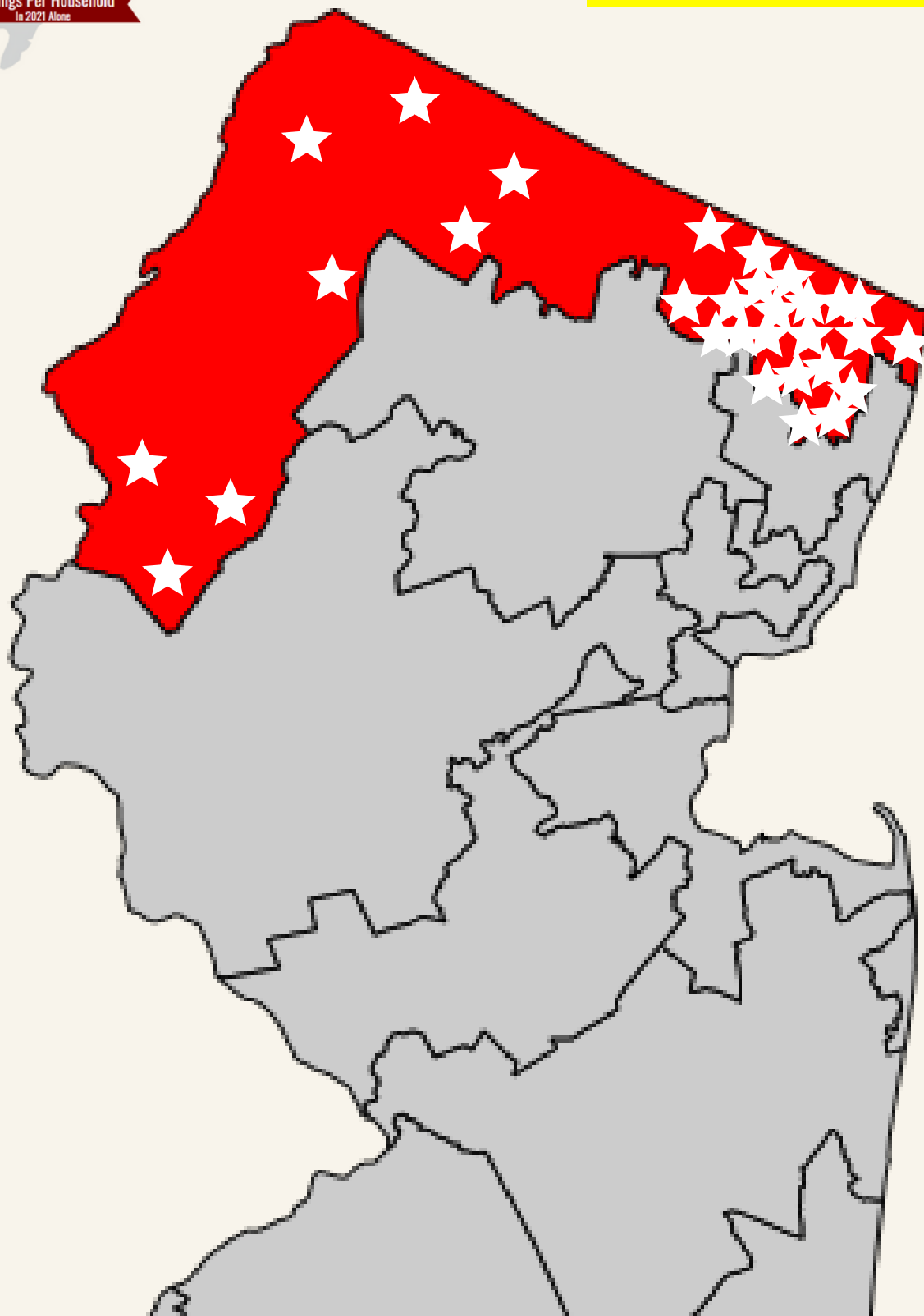

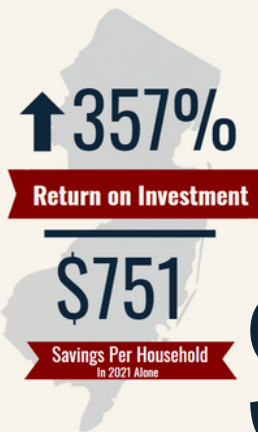


Assistance to Firefighters Grants

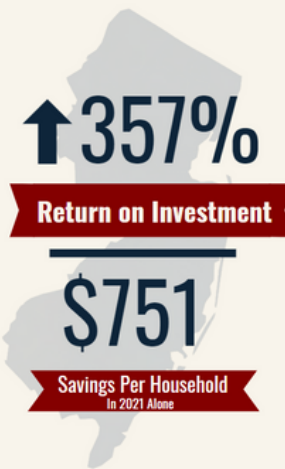


Non-Profit Security Grants

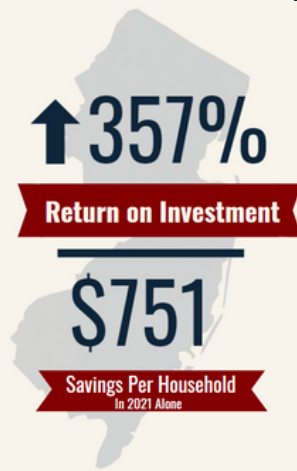

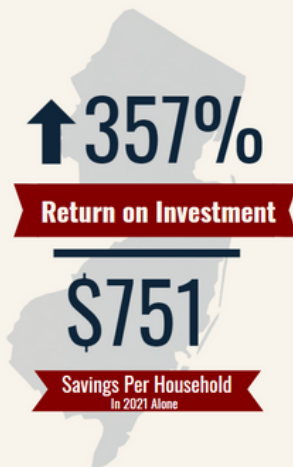
